Tekst of the week
 Joshua 24:15
 Choose today whom you will serve. Would you prefer the gods of our ancestors served beyond the Euphrates? Or will it be the gods of the Amorites in whose land you now live? But as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord.

Moses needed to choose. He is born Israelite, but raised in the palace of the Pharaoh. He wants to help his people but he needs to choose wisely.

Read Moses' struggle in the bible: Exodus 2:11-15

- Moses makes a clumsy mistake to stand up for the Israelites, God's people. What does he do?
 - He defeats the Pharaoh
 - He beats an Egyptian to death
- How did the Israelites respond?
 - They are thankful
 - They don't trust him
 - They keep silent
- What happens after this event?
 - Moses flees
 - Moses goes back to the palace of the Pharaoh

Moses maybe made a clumsy move, but God calls him later on to free the people of Israel. God sees this Young Hero!

Challenge of this week:
 Fill 5 cups with water and one without, like the Red Sea. Put them in a row. Place a pingpong ball on the first waterfilled cup and blow the ball to the next and so on. Who has reached the last empty cup? You can also make a contest with 2 rows.

God has chosen Moses before he was born, to lead the Israelites out of Egypt. But Moses need to choose to stand in God's plan as well. He even went to the desert where God spoke to him.
